




<p>LEXIA/Reading Plus Activity: Complete 4 units of Lexia or 1 combo of Reading Plus - This activity can be completed each SLED day and repeated with each SLED day if the student wishes to do so.</p> 	<p>Book Review: Read any book or magazine of your choice at home. Write the title of the book, a review of the it, explaining why you did or did not like the book. Make sure you explain who the characters were and summarizes the book.</p> 	<p>Writing/Social Studies Activity: What is your favorite holiday to celebrate? Write a paragraph (five sentences) explaining the traditions your family and you have for this specific day/time of the year.</p>	<p>REFLEX MATH Activity: Work on your fact fluency on Reflex Math until you receive a green light or acquire 20 new fluency facts for the day.</p> 
<p>Math Whizz: Complete 2 lessons with assessments (assessments are on the blue screen) of Math Whizz. (Mark with a MW on your Activity Log. This activity can be completed each SLED day and repeated with each SLED day if the students wishes to do so.</p> 	<p>Odd & Even/ Comparisons Task 1: Make a list of all the odd numbers between 1-30. Make a list of all the even numbers between 1-30. The best strategy to use for this may be a T-chart. Task 2: Create at least 6 comparison Math sentences using three digit numbers. Make sure that if you use examples like the bottom one that both sides of the equation are balanced and equal to one another. Examples below of comparisons- $325 < 549$ (less than) $325 > 216$ (greater than) $168 + 2 = 171 - 1$ (equal to)</p>	<p>Technology Activity: Answer the following on a separate sheet of paper: What is the safe thing to do if you get an email or a message from a stranger?</p>	<p>COMIC BOOK CREATION: Create a short comic book that includes at least six frames and illustrates the beginning, middle, and end of your favorite short story.</p>
