Put the weights of the dogs in order from least to greatest.</p> <p>Sherry has 30 pairs of shoes in her room, 15 pair has high hills, 7 of them are boots, and the rest are tennis shoes. How many pair is left? Show this as a fraction and a percent.</p> <p>Walter runs a 200 yard dash in 19.7 seconds. There is 3 feet in a yard. How many meters are in a 200 yard dash?
