What type of graph would be used to chart his weight gain over the next two weeks?</p> <p>If it takes Sarah 2 hours and 15 minutes to ride her bike 15 miles. How long will it take her to ride 75 miles?</p> <p>Chris walks $2\frac{2}{11}$ miles a day for 3 days and then he walks $3\frac{5}{11}$ miles the other two days.
