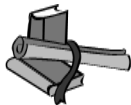

**PHILOSOPHY**— The Cumberland County Board of Education believes that an Adult Basic Education Program should be made available for the adults of Cumberland County who are interested in life long learning, which is provided by the Council for Post Secondary Education and KY Dept for Adult Education and KY Literacy Council.



1. **GOAL**—To provide eligible Cumberland County Adults an opportunity to increase their basic learning skills or to qualify for a High School Equivalency Diploma.

**LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES:**

- Adult Education Classes
  - 1) Must have a minimum of 12 seat hours before enrolling in Adult Education.
  - 2) A requirement of classroom instruction and homework hours are necessary before registering for the Official G.E.D. exam.
  - 3) You must pass all 4 sub tests of the OPT with a score of at least 150 before registering to take the Official G.E.D exam.
  - 4) If progress is not being made or there has been no activity for 90 consecutive days, the exit process will begin with separation from the adult education program.

- TABE Testing
- Computer Lab Accessibility with internet access
- National Career Readiness Test
- COMPASS Test
- Computer Classes (Word, Excel, etc.)
- KET
- Literacy Link/National Career Readiness Assessments/Workkeys
- Skill building
