MATH

On Monday Jim ate 540 and Tonya ate 460, on Tuesday Jim ate 650 and Tonya ate 700, on Wednesday Jim ate 1000 and Tonya ate 850, on Thursday Jim ate 900 and Tonya ate 950, and on Friday Jim ate 675 and Tonya ate 725. Make a double bar graph with this information. Who ate the most calories all week?

SCIENCE
