Agenda: A motion was made by Melissa Stalcup, seconded by Amber Ferguson, to adopt the February agenda.

Minutes: January minutes were read as prepared. A motion was made Amber Ferguson, seconded by Cassandra Huddleston, to approve January minutes as prepared.

Good News Report:

- a. February Student Newsletter was sent out with students last week.
- b. Students are being taught Ron Clark's 55 Essentials every morning during morning assembly. Rules teach students lesson in respect, compassion and responsibility.
- c. CCMS purchased Prize Wheel. Also implemented Panther Points reward system. Students can trade in points to spin wheel for prizes/rewards.
- d. Gear Up has had guest speakers who specialize in trade and technical careers to come to speak to students and parents each week. Program has went over well with both students and parents.
- e. FRYSC and Adanta brought guest speaker to CCMS last week to talk to students about the dangers of drug abuse and how it can affect families.
- f. Mrs. Bandy shadowed a student on Monday, Jan. 19th. Mrs. Bandy shared with SBDM that the experience was very eye-opening and showed her that our students are spending a large portion of the day on Chromebooks.
- g. Cumberland County School District will have a guest speaker on March 13th at CCMS. The speaker will talk about school shootings and how students and communities need to focus on compassion and acceptance.
- h. District administrators will have Run-Fight-Hide training on March 8th. They will then train all school staff.
- i. Mrs. Nathalie Vincent, CCMS school counselor, has been awarded KASC Counselor of the Year.

- a. 6th grade increased 27% in Math on MAP test with 71% growth.

School Improvement:

- a. SBDM reviewed schools 30/60/90 day plan. Members marked off completed activities and looked at activities that still need to be addressed.

- b. District has sent 2018-19 SBDM funds allocations. The current allocation is \$21,134.70.
