Agenda: A motion was made by Tabetha Cooksey, seconded by Melissa Stalcup, to adopt the December agenda.

Minutes: November minutes were read as prepared. A motion was made Melissa Stalcup, seconded by Jerry Hall, to approve November minutes as prepared.

New Business: Cassandra Huddleston made a motion to move item 8c from December agenda up to discuss Social Studies job opening an review submitted applications. Katie Sherrell seconded motion.

The council interviewed Jackie Paul for the Social Studies position.

Closed Session: Tabetha Cooksey made motion for council to move into closed session to discuss hiring for Social Studies position. Cassandra Huddleston seconded. After discussion Melissa Stalcup made motion to move back to open session. Dennis Sells seconded motion. The council made a motion to hire Jackie Paul for the Middle School Social Studies position at Cumberland County Middle School.

Good News:

- a. CCMS has started having morning assemblies every morning from 7:30 till 7:40 am.
- b. Mrs. Bandy shared with council that student behaviors are improving. Shared new behavior management plan that will give teachers more control over student behavior in classroom.

- c. **WIG updates:** CCMS Attendance WIG is 96%. CCMS is currently at 96% for the school year. CCMS Academic WIG is 60% of students will be proficient and distinguished in math and reading. Currently CCMS is at 50% proficient and distinguished.
- d. Mrs. Bandy shared with council that will begin a competition among grade levels. Winning grade will win trip to Beech Bend.
- e. 6 students have reached their AR goal and were provided lunch outside of school.
- f. Mrs. Bandy shared that CCMS still ranks higher than other middle schools in district on 16-17 KPREP.

Student Achievement:

- a. Second round of MAP testing will begin in January.
- b. Mrs. Bandy shared that student completed round 1 of CPAs on 12/13/17.
- c. CCMS sent a team of teachers to South Warren Middle School to observe their RTI program to see how we can improve our program.

School Improvement Planning:

- a. Mrs. Bandy shared that CCMS teachers have been trained in an anti-bullying program. Those teachers will train remaining staff and students in Spring.
- b. Council reviewed CSIP goals. Jerry Hall made a motion to approve the CSIP goals. Katie Sherrell seconded.

Budget Report:

- a. November budget report was not available for review due to early meeting date. Budget will be available for review upon counsel request.

New Business:

- a. Mrs. Bandy shared with council the CCMS would begin having student movie nights and a Spring Festival in 2018. Dennis Sells made motion to approve fundraiser request. Seconded by Tabetha Cooksey.

Review of Policies:

- a. Mrs. Bandy presented changes to the CCMS Discipline/Consequences Chart. Students will no longer have cell phones confiscated for cell phone violations. Cell phone consequences will be after school detention, out of school suspension

and possible alternative school referral. Tabettha Cooksey made motion to approve Cell Phone Violation policy. Dennis Sells seconded.

Ongoing Learning:

- a. Mrs. Bandy shared with council the PRIDE (Positive, respect, integrity, dedicated and dependable, and Excellence) Initiative.
