Your choice is between a nice river valley right in between a few large, well-established civilizations or a secluded island archipelago far away from other civilizations. Which would you choose? Why that one? Does the place you live dictate the type of life you lead? How do you think geography shapes a society? What if you lived on an archipelago 1000 years ago? What is the sixth number in this data set?</p> <p>Question 2: At 4:00 am., the temperature is -17°F. The temperature decreases 3°F per hour.
